outreach to kids at the Pleasant Hill Concert at the Lake on Sunday, July 8th was a success! With a table full of supplies and ideas for drawing, Glynda Dixon introduced children and their parents to drawing with colored pencils. For most of them it was new. Many people think art is a big messy experience, with water, oils, big canvases and then a lot of cleaning up. Colored pencils proved to be fun, creative and "clean"! The surprise of the involvement with pencils, even for the parents, caused one of them to sit down and start scribbling with pencils with his daughter.

Leslie Norgren sat with kids on the concrete seating by the fountain, helping them with their drawing. They had a wonderful time and were very proud of their work. Several parents thanked us for having the art table available.

However, as with any kid's activity, what was really priceless were some of their comments and questions. One of the kids suddenly asked me, "Who is your favorite artist?" I didn't quite know what to say. "Have you seen the Picasso exhibit? My class saw the exhibit and my favorite artist is Picasso." Another boy asked me what my name was, I responded with "Glynda the Good Witch!" He then asked me if any of my art was hanging on the panels. He went over to see the art and then came back,
