#### 2020 Treasurer's Report

January 1, 2020 balance -\$2,101.44. Income was \$1,948.45; Expenses were \$1,623.95. December 31, 2020 balance -\$2,426.34.

A major expense was \$703.61 for Bubble Wrap Bags. We expect to regain this as members continue to buy more of the bubble wrap bags. Email us your order!

Our two online auctions raised \$644.00. In January we sent a check to the Food Bank of Contra Costa and Solano for \$322 - one-half the proceeds from our auctions.

Thank you to all of the artists for donating your lovely work!

We plan to have additional art auctions this year - keep an eye out for future announcements.
