Moraga Art Gallery's "Singularities"

This show will be on display February 2 to April 10. The title "Singularities," is derived from the unique visions of the two featured member artists: *Orinda's Linh Kang* and *Walnut Creek's Susan Erickson*.

Using acrylics and oils overlaid with glossy resin, <u>Linh Kang</u>, renders larger-than-life emotionally-charged portraits of Southeast Asians. The portraits are an homage to her Asian heritage and her desire to explain the unexplainable through myths, dreams, and divine beliefs.

<u>Susan Erickson</u> uses memorabilia added to mixed media to create her detailed paintings which often carry a message designed to elicit an emotional response.
