For those who find it difficult to take pictures of your work, bring them to the general meeting and we will take pictures of them for you. It will help more if you bring a white tablecloth.

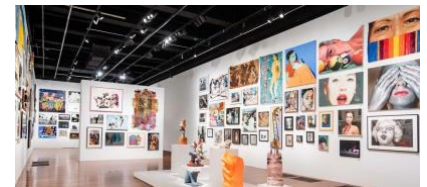

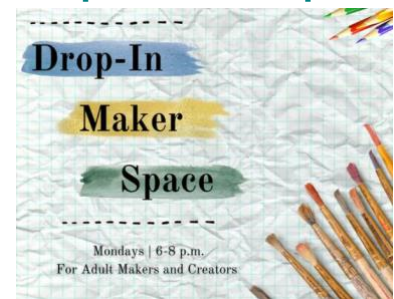
