Moraga Art Gallery's "Singularities"



"Come-And-Help-Your-Mother" by Susan Erickson

This show will be on display February 2 to April 10. The title "Singularities," is derived from the unique visions of the two featured member artists: *Orinda's Linh Kang* and *Walnut Creek's Susan Erickson*.

Using acrylics and oils overlaid with glossy resin, Linh Kang, renders larger-than-life emotionally-charged portraits of Southeast Asians. The portraits are an homage to her Asian heritage and her desire to explain the unexplainable through myths, dreams, and divine beliefs.

Susan Erickson uses memorabilia added to mixed media to create her detailed paintings which often carry a message designed to elicit an emotional response.
