Please Note our new hours.

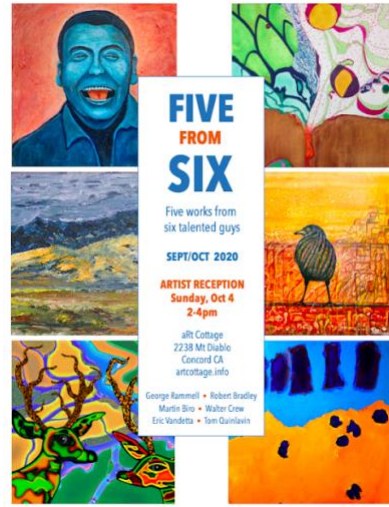
